### Action Project Ideas

- The Team should pick some attainable projects for this summer.
- **Traffic Slowing with Art:**

- Body outlines in crosswalks
  - A “gateway” at the entrances to town: banner, “art arch”, “dead” pick-ups or cars with trees in bed parked around town.
  - Farmers market or other street fairs on weekend on Main Street – a regular event that gains momentum
