- Dahvi asks Cari how she thinks we could possibly work with the church to plan a joint service day. Cari suggests going to the Bishops. (DAHVI WILL FOLLOW-UP WITH THE BISHOPS ABOUT PLANNING SUCH A DAY IN THE FUTURE.)
