Updates on Events and Results:

Next Steps:

- We need to find metrics for each of the drivers we identified through the workshops.
- Partners agree that Dahvi should work with Doug Walker, Bill Knight, and Cari Golden to think about what data sets we will need and what we have to assess the presence of these drivers.
- Dahvi will build out the mind map, and this will be used to build our cViz model.
- Partners do feel that there was enough participation and engagement from the community to be satisfied with the input we have received and move forward.
- Dahvi will check in with the facilitators of each circle to ensure that she accurately captured the ideas that were collected there.

Work Plan for the Rest of 2010:

- Partners approve of the schedule, and think this will work.
- They do not believe one public meeting per month is too ambitious.
- We agree to look at the budget again as we get a sense of how far our \$20,000 for visualization will take us with our model building.

Training Trip to Filmore, UT:

- Dahvi will attend CViz training in Filmore, not to be trained, but to understand what will be possible with the model, and to make sure that the training is orienting to meet project goals.
- Dahvi will work with Doug during this time to determine what the initial “base model” that Sunrise constructs should include. What should our expectations be?
